

## TAC UGADHI CUP 2018 RULES

1. There are 30 overs for each innings with a 10 minutes drinks break after 15 overs and a 30 minute Innings break.
2. Each game to start at 12:30 PM sharp and the end time is 6 PM.
3. Toss is to be held at 12:10 PM with both Captains under the supervision of the Official Umpire.
4. Bowling Team can choose whichever end to bowl at the start of the Innings.
5. The dress code is a White Pant and White Jersey to complement the RED Colour Cricket Ball.
6. Red King Kookaburra 156 grams to be used and the synthetic pitch to be used for all the games.
7. A bowler is allowed to bowl a maximum of 6 overs.
8. Any ball bowled down the leg side of the batsman is considered as a WIDE.
9. Field restrictions in the first 6 overs – 2 fielders only allowed outside the 30 yard circle.
10. Field restrictions in the overs 7 to 30 – only 5 fielders are allowed outside the 30 yard circle.
11. If a bowler ever delivers a ball overstepping the popping crease, it is a no-ball. The batting team gets one run for the ball and the next delivery is a free hit. In other words, in the next ball, the batsmen can only be dismissed through a run out.
12. There is a change of the bowling end for every 5 overs.
13. The same rule applies for above the waist ball, the main umpire has the authority to overrule if there is any controversial decision by the square leg umpire.
14. There would be 1 Official ACT Cricket Umpire for the preliminary round and square Leg Umpiring to be provided by the batting team.
15. There would be 2 official Umpires for semis and finals and these games are to be played as per the ICC Rules. **Rule 12** doesn't apply which means bowling will be from both ends for semis games and grand finale.
16. One Short Pitched ball is allowed per over.
17. **No more than 5 fielders are allowed on the on side.**
18. Any Player misbehaviour on the field is strictly prohibited and the main umpire has the authority to suspend the player or team from further participation in the tournament.
19. **It is the captain's duty in making sure that the game is played with good sportsmanship.**
20. A mandatory Registration fee of \$15 is to be paid by each player towards TAC Membership to participate in the tournament.
21. A player would be allowed to play the semis and Finals Only If he has played at least one game in the preliminary rounds.
22. The top 2 teams from each group would qualify for the semis at the completion of the preliminary round..
23. Non Telugu Players are not allowed to play from the current season of 2018 to facilitate all the enthusiastic TAC Registered Members,

24. A Telugu player is defined as a person whose mother tongue is Telugu i.e. either father or mother belongs to a Telugu family or a partner who belongs to a Telugu family or any other players who can communicate in TELUGU with the team.
25. Boundaries are of 55 metres or 60 yards length and the inner circle is marked to 30 yards.
26. 2 Points to be awarded to the winning team and a point each if the game is abandoned due to rain or bad weather.
27. Semis and Finals to be rescheduled in the case of rain or bad weather.
28. In the event of rain or bad weather, the officiating ACT Umpire will make a final decision as per the Duckworth Lewis system.
29. No Preliminary games to be rescheduled due to rain or bad weather.
30. A player found guilty of misconduct will be forced to sit out for the entire game.
31. The Main Umpire will have every authority to review and overrule the decision of the square Leg Umpire in regards to Stumping's and Run outs.
32. All 11 players from each team should be at the ground by 12:30 PM.
33. A New Award for the Team playing in the spirit of the game. This would be advised by the Official Umpires.
34. Awards to be distributed on 21<sup>st</sup> April @ TAC Ugadhi Sambaralu 2018 for the Best Bowler, Batsman, All-rounder and Man of the Series and Special Awards.
35. Volunteers required for each game in setting up the 30 yard circle, wickets and Boundaries/Cones.
36. BY runners are to be allowed only if both captains agree prior to the game.
37. This is a community event and TAC encourages all players to play with good sportsmanship and develop harmony and well being.
